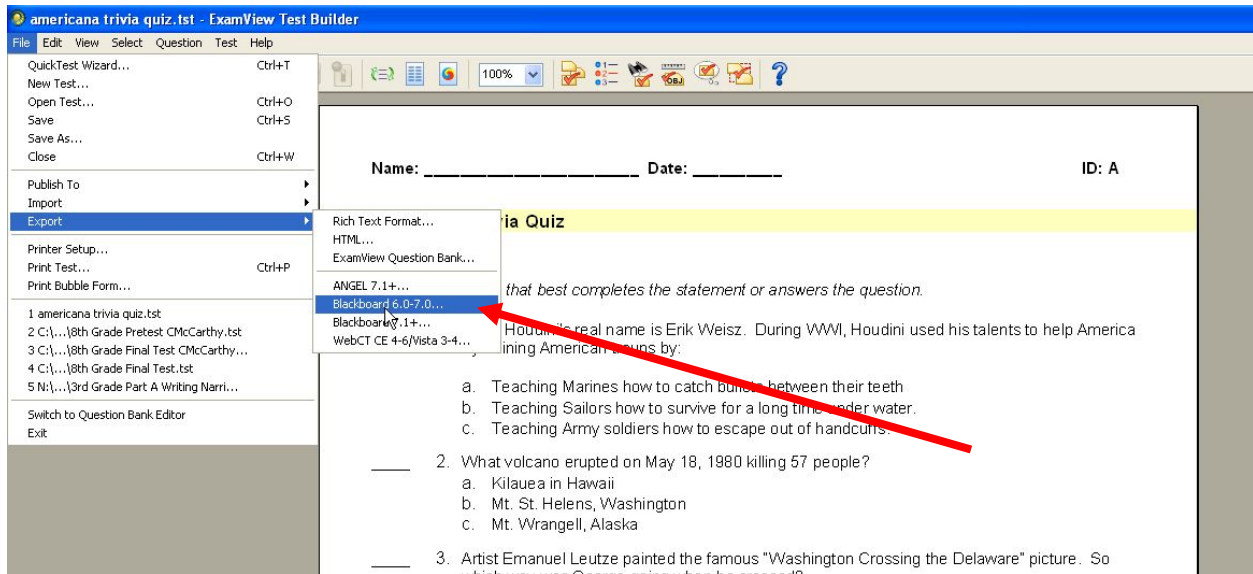
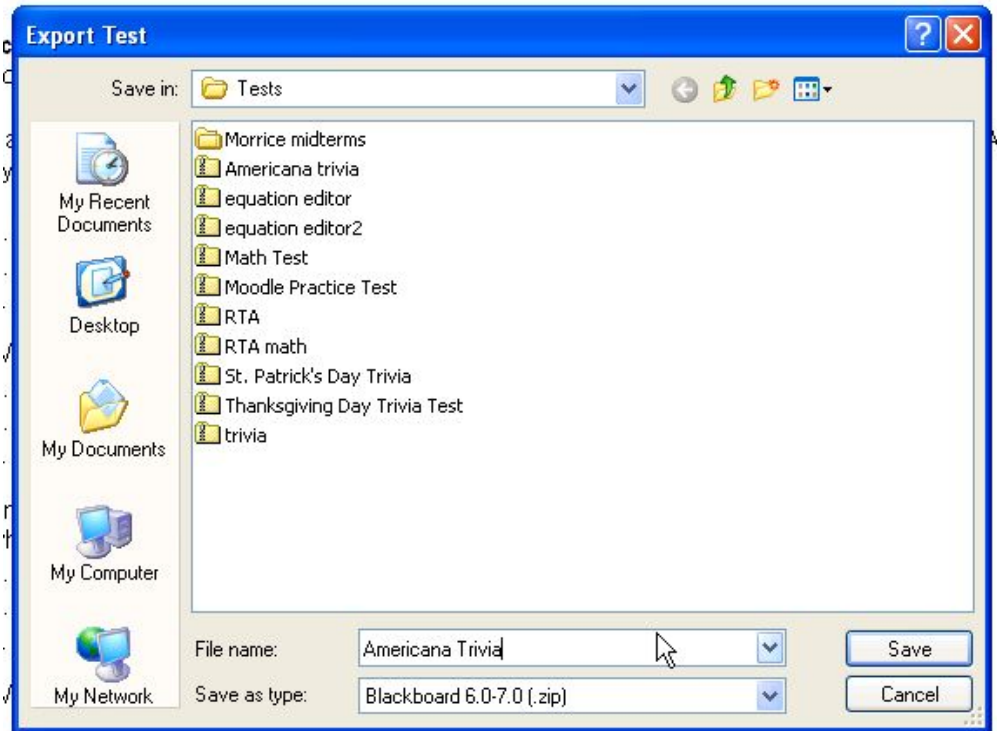


# Importing ExamView Tests into Moodle

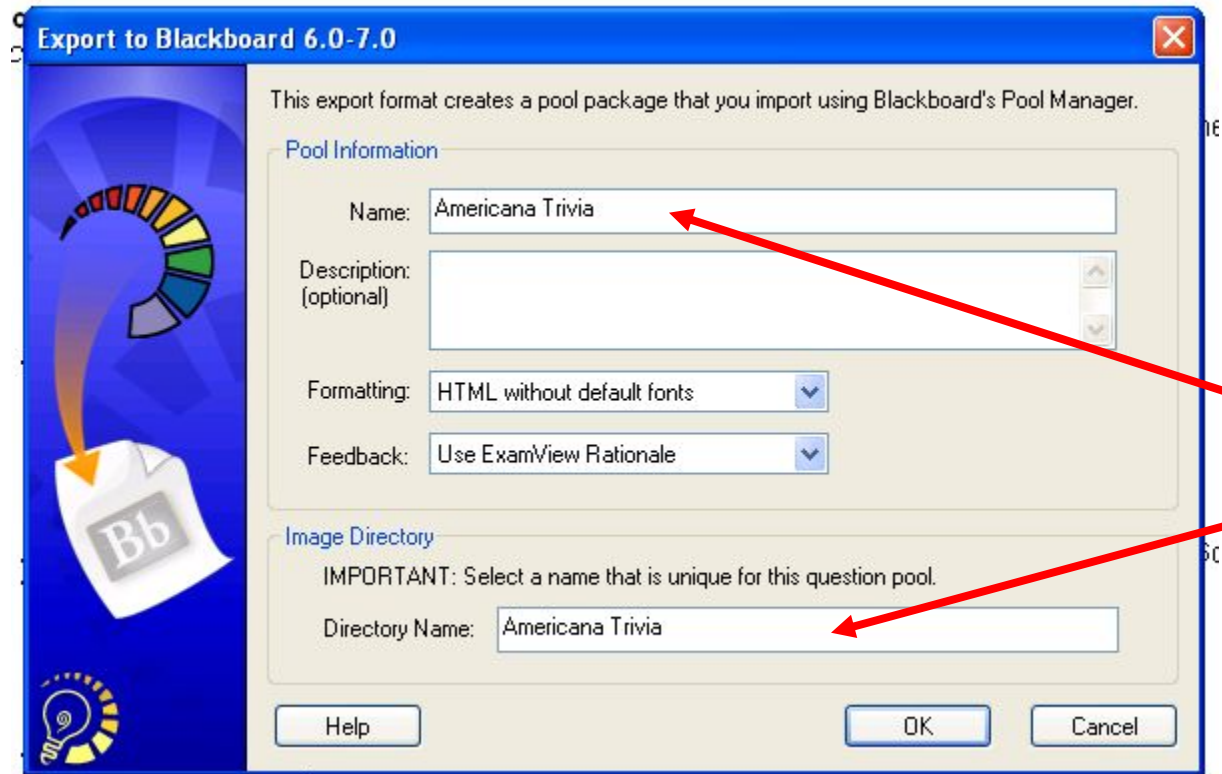
1. After you create your test in ExamView, go to **File** → click on **Export** → **Blackboard (6.0-7.0)**



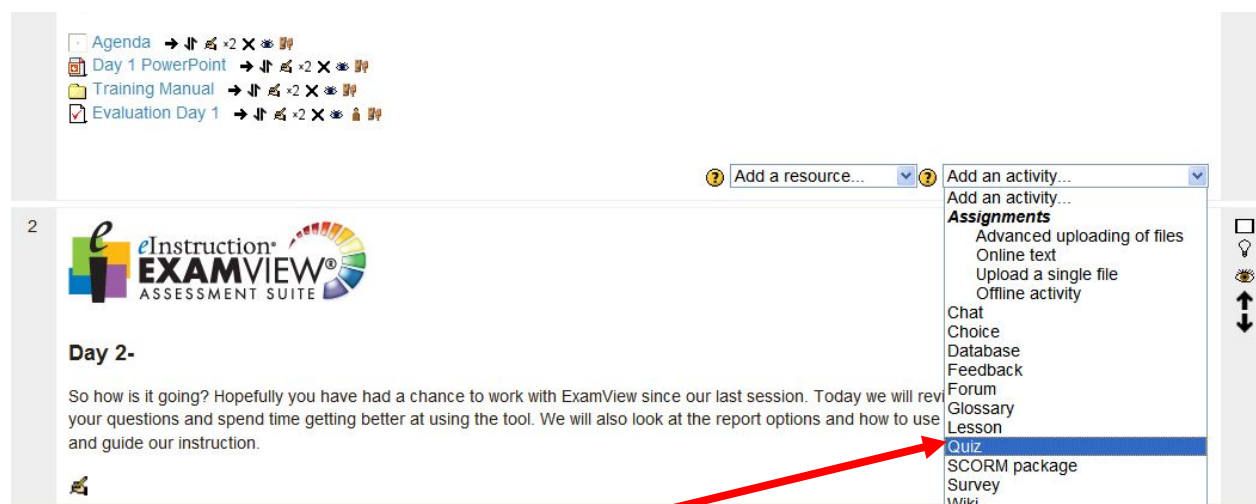
2. When the dialog box appears, name the test file (this creates a .zip file).
3. Click **OK**.



- When the Pool Information dialog box appears, give a name in the Name field and in the Image Directory name field. (Note: Just name them both the same as the .zip file or test name.)
- Click **OK** ( You are now done with ExamView and can close the program).



- Open your Moodle account.--> Choose the topic area where you want the test to appear. → Choose **Quiz** from the **Add an Activity** listing.



7. Name the Quiz and choose the information necessary for the quiz.

**Note:** At this point you may want to click on **Categories** (Settings → Quiz Administration → Question Banks → Categories) to predefine a category where you want the questions you are about to import to go. This will save you time when you are selecting questions and keep your Question Bank organized. It is recommended that you name the category the same as the ExamView questions you are importing.

12. If you predefined a Category, select it from the dropdown menu under General.

13. Click **Choose a file.**

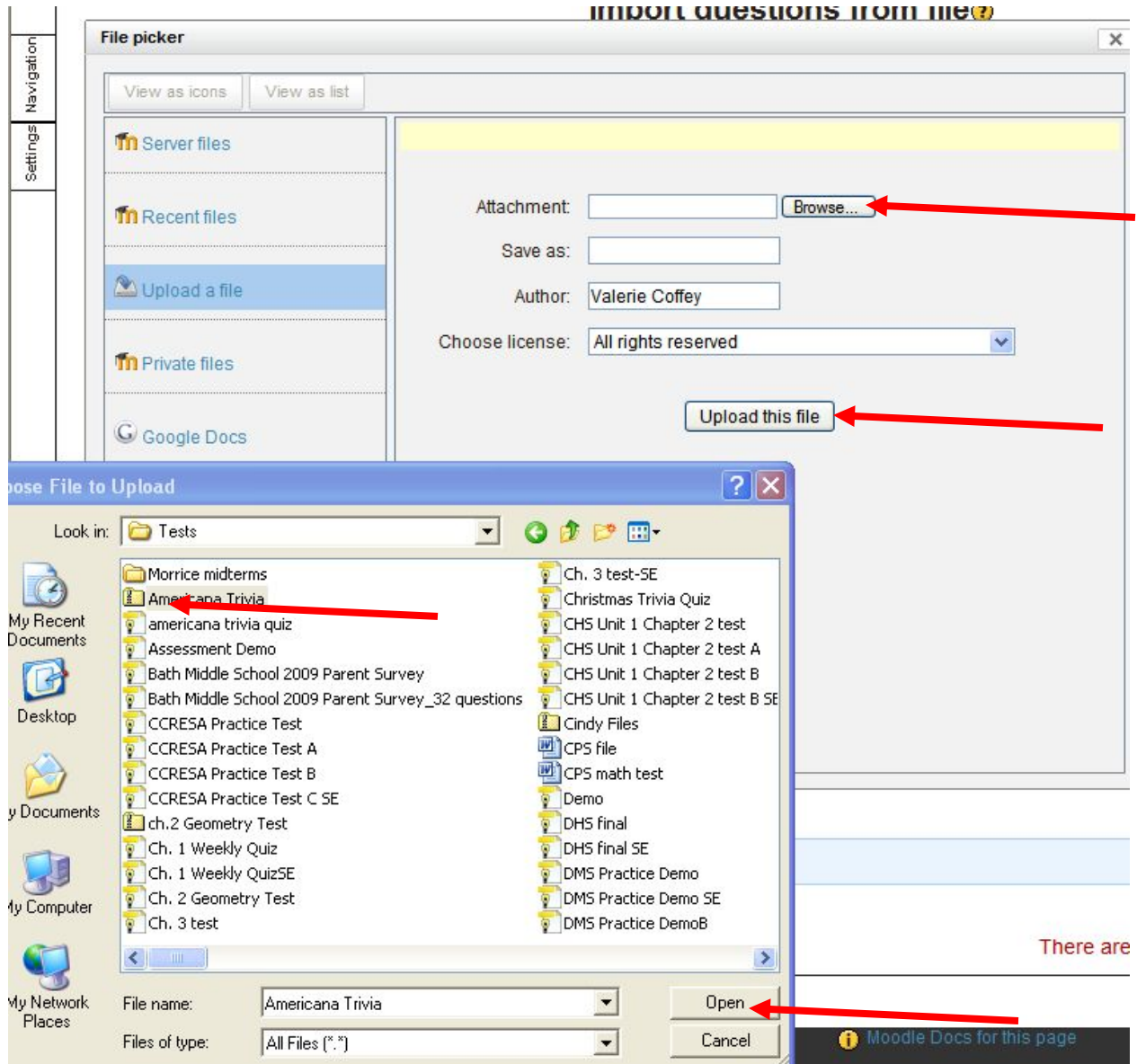

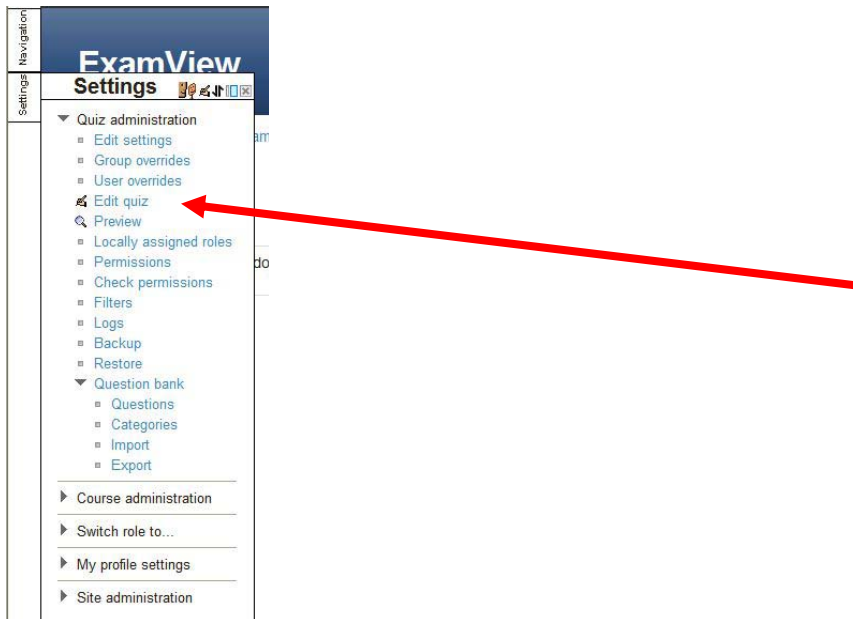

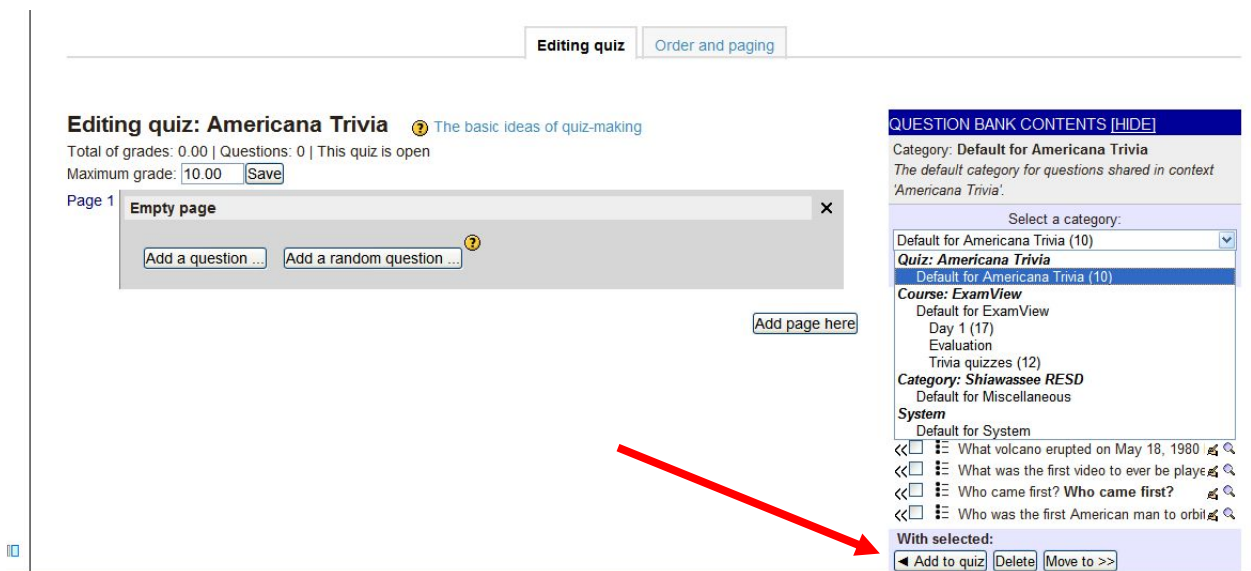


19. The questions are now in a "Question Bank" which can be re-used as needed. Now they need to be added to your quiz. **Go to Settings→Quiz Administration→Edit Quiz**



20. Make sure you are on the **Editing Quiz** Tab, select the category your quiz questions are under.

21. Click the  next to each question or to **Select All**, click on the  above the first question. Then click **Add to Quiz** at the bottom of the screen.



22. The questions will appear on the left side of the screen. You can rearrange the questions if needed. (Note: The Order and Paging is another option for this). Also, if you want to change the number of questions per page, this can be done under the **Settings**→**Quiz Administration**→**Edit Settings**.

23. Click on the **Settings**→**Quiz Administration**→**Preview** to see the test. You can take the test as a practice test if you wish.
